The Cat Fanciers' Association, Inc. licenses this show. CFA show rules will be strictly enforced. Copies of the current show rules can be obtained from CFA, Inc., 1805 Atlantic Ave., PO Box 1005, Manasquan, NJ 08733-0805 for \$5.00. All Championship, Premiership and registered Kitten entries will be scored for CFA Regional and National Awards.

Entries: A signed entry form must accompany each entry. All Fees must accompany entry. No postdated checks will be accepted. Please make checks payable to Alamo City Cat Club. After making a faxed or online entry, payment should be mailed immediately.

Cages: Single cages are 22"X22"X22" and double cages are 22"X22"X45". Provide your own cage curtains and top and bottom cover-ups. Benching requests made at time of entry will be honored when possible. Bring your own cat food, dishes and litter pans.

Kitten Sales: You must purchase a For Sale Cage in order to sell cats or kittens at this show unless they are entered in the show. One adult or two kittens per 1/2 cage space. Proof of age may be required for very small kittens. No cat or kitten may be sold for less than \$100.00. **No kittens under 4 months of age** are allowed in the show. All cats and kittens must be transported in a carrier.

Veterinary: This is a non-vetted show. All entries must be inoculated against rabies, feline enteritis, feline rhinotracheitis, calici virus, and should test negative for feline leukemia and feline immunodeficiency virus. All entries must be free of fleas, fungus, and ear mites. The Show Committee reserves the right to remove any cat or kitten from the show hall if suspected of having any of the above conditions until examined by a veterinarian at the owner's or agent's expense. Cat's claws must be clipped on all four feet. **Declawed cats are ineligible for entry per CFA rules.****Liability:** Reasonable care of cats and other property will be provided. However; neither Alamo City Cat Club nor the Live Oak Civic Center will be liable for any loss or damage to a cat, exhibitor, or their personal property. **No cats may be left in the show hall overnight.**

Show Hall: The Show Hall is climate controlled. Free Parking. Show Hall is accessible to those with disabilities. It is a **NO SMOKING SHOW.**
