SHOW HOTEL: LaQuinta Inn & Suites, 311 Stadium Drive, Waxahachie, Texas. This LQ is under 2 years of age. 972-937-5525, mention cat show to get \$62 rate. LQ is east of the show hall on south side of 287 Bypass. Take the US 77 exit off the bypass. From the south (from Corsicana/Interstate 45), take US 77 exit, go under the overpass, take a left and stay on the access road. From the north (US 287), take the US 77 exit and stay on the access road. From Interstate 35E north, take the 287 exit (Corsicana) and take the US 77 exit. Stay on access road. From Interstate 35E south, take the 287 exit (toward Corsicana) and stay on access road past US 77.

SHOW HALL: Ellis County Youth Expo Center is handicapped accessible and heated; there is no air-conditioning. Smoking is not permitted in the show hall.

There will be no concession stand. However, Ozark Cat Fanciers will provide turkey, ham and sodas for lunch; exhibitors are invited/encouraged to bring a vegetable, salad, dessert or whatever. Please

There are fast-food restaurants within 1-2 miles.

Litter will be provided; please bring litter pans and cat food and cage curtains.

SHOW HALL DIRECTIONS: From west/north on US 287, stay on US 287 Bypass (not 287 business route). Take FM 664 Ovilla exit, circle over US 287 and stay on access road. **From east/south** on US 287 Bypass, take FM 664 Ovilla exit, stay on access road. Show hall is on right. **From I35E from south**, take US 287 north (Fort Worth/Midlothian) exit, then take FM 664 Ovilla exit and stay on access road. **From I-35E from north**, take US 287 north (Fort Worth/Midlothian) exit, then take FM 664 exit; stay on access road. The building is yellow and to the south of the Cowboy Church.

SCORING and AWARDS: Championship, premiership and registered kitten entries will be scored for CFA national and regional awards. Ribbons and rosettes will be awarded according to CFA rules. This show is licensed by the Cat Fanciers Association Inc., and its show rules will be strictly enforced. A copy of CFA show rules can be obtained for \$5 from CFA, Box 1005, Manasquan, NJ 08736-1005, or at www.cfainc.org. **All championship, premiership, provisional breed, miscellaneous and AOV entries must be entered with a CFA registration number.**

There will be no veterinarian inspection before benching. It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline enteritis, feline rhinotracheitis, calici viruses and rabies. Please bring proof of rabies vaccination. It is also recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative of FeLV before entry. All cats/kittens must be free of parasites, fungus and contagious diseases.

All claws of all entries must be clipped prior to benching. Declawed kittens/cats cannot be shown under CFA rules.

Only exhibitors may sell cats or kittens at the show. Agents without an entry may not sell cats or kittens.

CAGES are 21 X 21 X 21 single or 21 X 21 X 45 double. Cage sizes may vary. Cages must be covered on the bottom, back, sides and top.

REASONABLE CARE WILL BE TAKEN OF ALL ENTRIES, MERCHANDISE AND PERSONAL ITEMS. However, neither Ozark Cat Fanciers nor Ellis County Youth Expo Center will be liable for items lost, damaged or stolen.
