**SHOW HOTEL & TRANSPORTATION** Clarion, 314 West Bijou, Colorado Springs, CO 80905, 719-471-0309. Rates are \$65 per night, no pet deposit. Ask for Cat Fanciers 2010 rate. Airport shuttle service will be provided by the hotel from 6:00 am to 11:00 pm.

**SHOW HOURS** 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday and 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. Sunday. Check-in Saturday 7:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. Cats not checked-in by 8:30 a.m. will be marked absent. Judging starts promptly at 9:00 a.m. Saturday and 8:00 a.m. on Sunday.

**SHOW HALL** The building is heated but not air-conditioned. No outside food/drink permitted except for grand cakes. Cats are NOT TO BE LEFT IN THE SHOW HALL unless the owner(s) are present. There is no night watchman on duty. Neither the show management nor the Rocky Mountain Cat Fanciers Club shall be liable for any loss or damage to such property.

**CAGES** Single cages are 21" X 21" X 21". Double cages are 21" X 21" X 46". A single cage is provided for each entry. **Those not purchasing a double cage will have another cat benched in the other half cage.** Provide your own curtains and top and bottom cover-ups. Litter is provided but please bring your own litter tray. **No kittens** under 4 months of age are allowed in the show hall. CFA litter registration must be presented to the show management upon request or kitten(s) must be removed from the show hall immediately. **No** cats or kittens permitted in carriers under the benching tables. **No** un-entered cats or kittens may be in the show hall without show manager approval.

**VENDORS** The booth space is 10' X 10' which includes one table for \$65.00. \$10.00 each for extra table and/or electrical outlet. Contact Bob or Virginia Hale (719) 569-0101 for complete information and vending contract.

**SHOW CATALOG** Our show catalog is included with the first entry. Additional catalogs can be purchased at check-in. Marked catalogs are not available for this show.

**HOUSEHOLD PETS** Rocky Mountain Cat Fanciers welcomes household pets. Pets must be 4 months of age or older. Those over 8 months must be spayed or neutered. No declawed cats. For further information or assistance on this contact Sally or Mark Delman at (303) 400-8919.

**JUDGES** Rocky Mountain Cat Fanciers reserves the right to add judges not named in the show announcement to judge non-championship and non-premiership rings.

**AWARDS** Ribbons and rosettes are awarded according to CFA rules. Permanent awards are used for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places and for color class awards. Flat ribbons are available for those receiving awards. All championship, premiership, and registered kittens are scored for CFA national and regional awards.

**CLERKS** In order to run an efficient show, we are contracting for chief ring clerks. All clerks are paid according to their clerking program status. Please contact the entry clerk or show manager if you are interested.

**ENTRIES AND FEES** Make checks payable to Rocky Mountain Cat Fanciers or RMCF. Each entry must be on a signed CFA entry blank or exact facsimile. For entry clarification, the entry clerk will call collect. All entries must be paid prior to show. All exhibitors must be in good financial standing with RMCF for their entry to be accepted.

No adult, provisional, or miscellaneous entry will be accepted without a proper CFA registration number. If entry confirmation is not received within 15 days, contact the entry clerk. Please no calls after 9 p.m. Mountain Time.

This CFA licensed show is held in accordance with the CFA show rules. Copies may be obtained by sending \$5.00 to CFA, PO Box 1005, Manasquan, NJ. 08736.

**BENCHING** NON-VETTED SHOW! Any entry found with fleas, ear mites, fungus, or signs of illness will not be admitted. Any cat from a house or cattery where there has been feline distemper (panleukopenia) within 21 days prior to the opening date of the show is ineligible for entry and should entry have been made prior to the onset of any such condition, such entry is ineligible for admission into the show room. It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered in the show be inoculated by a licensed veterinarian against feline enteritis, feline rhinotracheitis, calici viruses and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested for FeLV and found negative before entry. Cat's claws must be clipped on all four paws. **DECLAWED CATS ARE INELIGIBLE FOR ENTRY.**

**Sale of cats or kittens is prohibited.**
